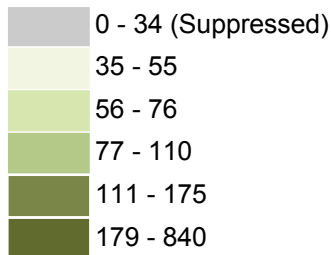

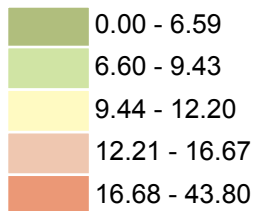

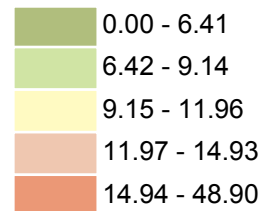

Percent Vulnerable



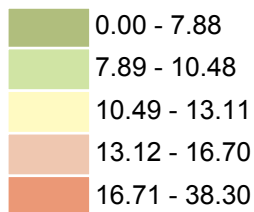
Social Competence

Percent Vulnerable



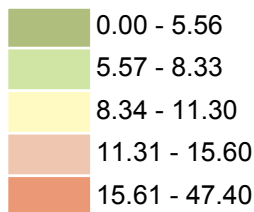
Emotional Maturity

Percent Vulnerable



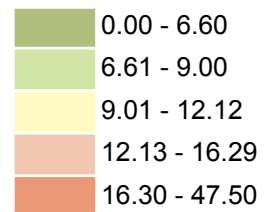

Percent Vulnerable



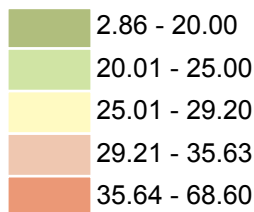

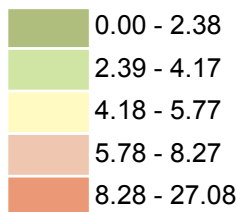
Vulnerable on One or More

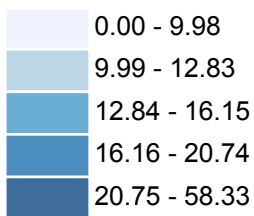

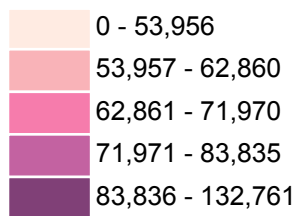

Further Explanation of Socioeconomic Variables:

Language: The percentage of the population with no knowledge of either English or French

Transiency: The percentage of the population that has moved in the last year

Education: The percentage of the population age 25 to 64 without a certificate, diploma, or degree

Family Structure: The percentage of families headed by a lone-parent

Income: Median Family Income in dollars
